Topic: *Sustainable Economic Transformation in the MENA Region: From Policy to Practice*

Dr. Leila Dagher is the Founding Director of the *Center for Policy Action* and Associate Professor of Economics and Policy at the *Lebanese American University*. She has been an adjunct lecturer at *George Washington University* since 2016 and currently serves as an *Editor of Energy Policy* and as a board member for four other journals.

Her research focuses on energy, environmental economics, and financial crises. Ranked among the *Top 2% Scientists worldwide (Stanford/Elsevier 2024)*, she has authored over 30 peer-reviewed papers and contributed to both academic and policy discussions internationally.

Previously, she served as Economic Adviser to public officials, Director of the Institute of Financial Economics, and Chairperson of the Department of Economics at AUB.

Dr. Dagher holds a *Ph.D. in Mineral Economics* from the *Colorado School of Mines* and a *Bachelor of Engineering* from the *American University of Beirut*. She has also taught at Harvard's Kennedy School and conducted research with the U.S. Department of Energy's National Renewable Energy Laboratory.

 **Prof. Sadok El Ghou** *University of Texas at El Paso, USA*

Topic: *Green Finance, ESG Integration, and Corporate Sustainability in the Post-Crisis Era*

Prof. Sadok El Ghou is a Professor of Business Administration at *University of Texas at El Paso, USA*. He received his *M.B.A. and Ph.D. from Laval University* and previously taught international financial management there.

His research interests include *corporate finance, corporate governance, CSR, international finance, and the role of culture in financial markets*. His work has been published in leading journals such as *Journal of Financial and Quantitative Analysis, Review of Finance, Management Science, Journal of International Business Studies, Journal of Business Ethics, The Accounting Review, and Contemporary Accounting Research*.

Prof. El Ghou has received numerous awards, including the *Moskowitz Prize (2011)*, the *McCalla Professorship (2013–2014)*, and several *Best Paper Awards* at international conferences. He serves as *Associate Editor at the Journal of Banking & Finance, Subject Editor at Emerging Markets Review*, and as a board member of several leading academic journals.
